Hi Folks!

Welcome to the Tilted Steeple Coffee House's third season! We have a lot of great talent lined up for this year, and we hope you will come out and enjoy it with us!

ALMOST SYNCHRONIZED is a small brass and beats band comprised of four local teens who first performed in the spring of 2017 at the *Brushes, Brass and Chocolate* Fundraiser hosted by the Iroquois United Church. Since then they have played at a variety of local events. **Nick Howard** (tenor sax), **Derrik Jansen** (drummer), **Jayden Rowe** (baritone sax), and **Bryce St Pierre** (trumpet), all students at Seaway District High School, will keep you entertained with a variety of popular hymns, classical, rock, and pop songs that are familiar to many generations.

THE K-TOWNE TRIO is made up of **Ken Julien**, guitarist and singer-songwriter, **Anne Lyon**, singer, and **Peter Johnson**, guitarist, singer and escaped retired teacher. They have been singing together for nearly four years, performing in coffee houses, Legions, church halls, retirement homes and restaurants in a blend reminiscent of such icons as Peter, Paul & Mary, The Kingston Trio and Ian & Sylvia. Their approach to acoustically-backed popular folk music makes them very easy to listen to and to sing along with. They have also been known to take requests and occasionally, Ken Julien, who performed a solo set at TSCH last season, can be coaxed into singing one of his original compositions.

Jon Martin has been an Anglican priest for a decade, and at St. James Church in Morrisburg since June 2015. Jon, who grew up in Ingleside, is deeply passionate about social justice and providing a safe place for those who don't always fit into the stereotype. He developed a love for music at a young age and played with several Ottawa bands to help pay for seminary. Jon loves pop punk, rock, and folk and is especially fond of East Coast music, playing everything from Blue Rodeo to Barenaked Ladies to Britney Spears.

PLAIN FOLK is the group made up of **Isabelle Delage**, the organizer and host of the Tilted Steeple Coffee House, and her bandmates from Montreal, **Mick Perreux** and **Val Teodori**. Together they perform some of Isabelle's original material along with other songs, mostly from the Canadian folk repertoire. Originally from Montreal but now making her home in Morrisburg, Isabelle is a singer-songwriter and the mother of "five-to-six children", who draws her inspiration from daily life, writing songs that tell a story about life, love, loss and hope. She has recorded three CDs, two with Plain Folk and a solo CD whose title track, *The Inundation*, is based on the story of the Lost Villages. She is currently working on her second solo album.
