We're delighted that **TED GUTHRIE** is back this year to entertain our Tilted Steeple audience. Ted is a retired Lutheran priest, currently serving as Honourary Associate Priest at St. Paul's Anglican Church in Brockville. After playing in a rock band in high school, he performed at coffee houses on campus in the late 60s. Working for over 20 years in correctional or mental health chaplaincy, he had many opportunities to lead group hymn singing and popular music singalongs. Ted's contribution as the Tilted Steeple's sound man is highly valued.

**LARA ANTEBI** is a singer-songwriter and multi-instrumentalist from Montreal who enchants and inspires with her soaring melodies and her honest and evocative lyrics. The mood is sometimes nostalgic, sometimes playful, but she always draws the listener in with her raw spirit and her colorful cast of characters. Lara's first full-length album, "Skin Collection", features 11 tracks of original songs touching on themes of starting over, delivered with a dark yet quirky and sensitive edge. Drawing on rock, folk, country, jazz and classical influences, her sound is often likened to that of Alanis Morissette, Carole King and Paul McCartney.
