Hi everyone! The last time we published this newsletter, far were we from suspecting that it would be the last for some two and a half years! The TSCH is thrilled to be back and hopes you will join us on this joyous reopening in our new venue for a wonderful evening of music and spoken word.

TSCH organizer and host **Isabelle Delage** and **Sam Moss** have been singing together since 2018, sometimes as a duo, other times as members of **Plain Folk** together with **Mick Perreux** and **Val Teodori**. To while away the time during the pandemic, they embarked on a recording project that was carried out as restrictions allowed, some in person, some using remote technology. The resulting album, entitled **The Lockdown Sessions**, features 18 cover songs in a variety of styles, from which they will select for their performances at the Tilted Steeple throughout the year. For this comeback performance, they will perform a combination of duets, numbers with **Mick** and **Val**, and even a few with guest **Claude Plamondon**, with whom they collaborated in the past year.

Newly established in Embrun, **Silvia Fiorita Smith** has had a passion for writing all her life, but publishing is a fairly recent venture. Her first book of poetry, **Figs Beneath the Snow**, came out during the pandemic. Her next collection of poems is due out soon. Silvia also dabbles in creative non-fiction; she won second place in a magazine contest and made the long list for the **CBC Literary Prizes**. She has often read from her works at Montreal's **Side Door Coffee House**, and was a long-time member of the West Island Writers' Group. She is now working on a lifetime ambition... a fictional novel.

**Claude Champagne, Claude (Cool-Eye) Clement** and **Claude (Plum) Plamondon** form the basic lineup of **Plum's Too Young to Die Band**. All seasoned musicians who have been playing since their early teens (or before), the three Claudes will be bringing a slew of original songs and perhaps a few covers to the Tilted Steeple. They have been friends since childhood, and this closeness comes across in their interactions on stage and with the audience. "Our hope is that when the audience leaves, it leaves with some thoughts, feelings or emotions it didn't have when it came in. If our music can do that, then we've accomplished our goal. Hope you enjoy!!"

As in the past, we will be ending the evening with an audience participation song led by "Plum" that is sure to send everyone home in a happy mood!
