Having had fun and success collaborating with musicians, playing around Montreal and Cornwall for over 12 years, **VIRGINIA DIPIERRO**'s life took a different direction during the pandemic. *Melodies and Memories*, a local TV show made possible by YourTV Cornwall, was born out of the need for seniors to be able to continue to have music during the shutdown.
