Her style is informed by an eclectic musical background, and a love of the songwriting greats - Leonard Cohen, Joni Mitchell, Townes Van Zandt and Tom Waits. Until 2015, her songs were the vehicle for the alt-folk band Zoë & the Lost Boys, who released two albums – *Joints (Muscles, Seams)* in 2011 and *Love Lives Here* in 2013.
