THREE FOR THE SHOW is a trio made up of Ken Julien, Cholly Boland and Anne **Lyon**. Hailing from Kemptville, Ken is a singer-songwriter as well as an avid hunter and arborist. He is currently recording a CD of his original songs. Cholly comes from a music-teaching family and has played in bands and sung in choirs for many years, performing at such events as the Ole Towne Hall Christmas Show and the Dairyfest Gospel Fest. Anne has worked as a nurse and Pastoral Care Coordinator. A member of the Good News Singers Music Ministry for 20 years, she has recorded two Gospel CDs.

ZOË ROBERTSON is a singer-songwriter and artist from Oka, Quebec by way of Montreal. Since 2011, she has performed dozens of shows, from North Bay, ON to Edmunston, NB, with many stops along the way. She has released four albums of original music, most recently in May of 2023. These songs were performed with her band from 2011-2015, but didn't find a home in an album until now.
