## **CORY M. COONS**

Growing up South of Ottawa, **Cory M. Coons** has been performing, writing and recording music since the age of 13. His influences are a collection of various genres like Melodic Rock and Roots-Rock, with previous hints of Southern & Country-Rock. In 2015 he was nominated as "Rock Artist of the Year" at the Los Angeles Music Awards. In 2014 he received the prestigious Producers Choice Award for "Studio Album of the Year" for his independent EP *Share A Little Time*, and was also nominated in the "Male Singer/Songwriter" and "Record of the Year" categories. Cory is a respected freelance guitar instructor in the St. Lawrence Seaway Valley and at the Rock My House Music Centre in Kemptonville. He has opened and performed alongside such treasured Canadian Artists as April Wine, Kim Mitchell, Glass Tiger, David Wilcox & Prairie Oyster. Their sound has been likened to The Kingston Trio, Peter, Paul & Mary and The Eagles, but **Æternal** cannot be pigeonholed: they own their own sound. ## **IAN HANCHET**

Ian Hanchet is a graduate of the Jazz program at Concordia University and the Music education program at McGill University and is currently teaching Music with the English Montreal School Board. *New Life* is Ian's third CD release and offers totally original songs in two rather disparate but complementary styles. Nine of the 15 original compositions feature the alto saxophone of Dave Turner complementing the trio of Ian on guitar and vocals, Adrian Vedady on upright bass and Sergio Barrenechea on Latin percussion and Congas. The other songs are coffee house type music a la Bruce Cockburn/ Bob Dylan/ Neil Young/ Jesse Winchester. **PLAIN FOLK** is the group made up of **Isabelle Delage**, the organizer and host of the Tilted Steeple Coffee House, joined by her bandmates from Montreal, **Mick Perreux** and **Val Teodori**. Together they perform some of Isabelle's original material along with other songs, mostly from the Canadian folk repertoire. Originally from Montreal but now making her home in Morrisburg, Isabelle is a singer-songwriter who draws her inspiration from daily life, writing songs that tell a story about life, love, loss and hope. She has recorded three CDs, two with Plain Folk and a solo CD whose title track, *The Inundation*, is based on the story of the Lost Villages. She is currently working on her second solo CD.
