CARIBOU STEW is a Folk/Americana band from Montreal. Since forming in 2013, Jared Otter (lead vocals) and Benjamin Vallée (instrumentation/harmony vocals) have been crossing all subgenres under the umbrella of Americana, exploring and discovering along the way. After playing on the Emerging Artists Stage at Montreal's Folk Festival on the Canal in 2016, they decided to head into the studio and record their debut EP and release it in January 2017. Mixing Folk, Bluegrass, Alt-Country, and their awkward adolescent charm, they're bound to catch your ear from the moment they start playing. This just in: Caribou Stew is now a 6-member band, and the whole ensemble is coming out to perform at TSCH!



Born in Lachute, Quebec, from a French Canadian mother and a Palestinian father, **GUILLAUME**JABBOUR is the recipient of the 2017 Stingray French Music Award. Guillaume fronts original music band Jabbour (Bill Collier, Carl Rufh) and provides guitar and vocal accompaniment in other musical projects, such as Montreal Cajun band and **Les Flâneurs** (Harlan Johnson, Bill Gossage). He credits his bi-ethnic childhood home for the development of his musical tastes and songwriting abilities. Playing solo, Guillaume pulls from his extensive repertoire, paying homage to songwriters such as David Wilcox, Paul McCartney, Félix Leclerc and other greats, and from his own material, which he writes English and French.
