ALMOST SYNCHRONIZED is a small brass and beats band comprised of four local teens from the Seaway District High School music program who first performed in the spring of 2017 at the *Brushes, Brass and Chocolate* Fundraiser hosted by the Iroquois United Church. Since then they have played at a variety of local events, and have been writing and recording their own music.
